1. Candidates must bring copy of Application form and other relevant documents related to admission and selection to M.A./M.Sc. received from C.U.
2. Two passport sized photographs (which need not be attested).
3. Original and Attested copy of mark-sheet of the last examination passed and Admit Card of Secondary or equivalent examination showing the date of birth (to be attested by the Head of the Institution last attended/Gazetted Officer).
4. Original and Attested copy of SC/ST/OBC Certificate (for SC/ST/OBC Candidates only). SC/ST/OBC candidates from other states (i.e., outside West Bengal) will be considered as General Candidates.
5. Original and Attested copy of BPL certificate if applicable.

6. Original and attested copy of Migration and Equivalence certificates if applicable.
 7. For physically handicapped candidates original certificate must be produced (proving at least 40% of disability) and attested copy of certificate must be submitted at the time of Verification.
 8. Laminated mark-sheets will not be entertained.
 9. All attestations should be done by the Head of the Institution last attended or any Gazetted Officer.
